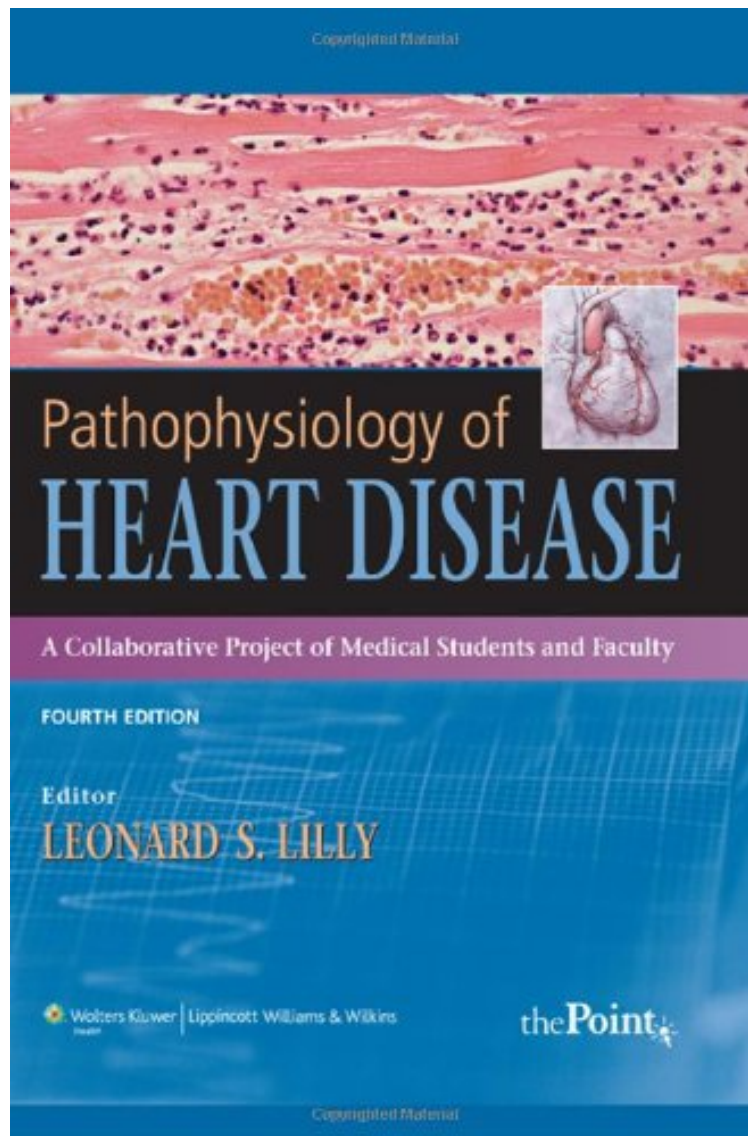

By ellie just finished the cardiovascular unit and this was one of our assigned textbooks. normally i never buy textbooks because i don't do the reading and feel like i wasted my money. this time i decided it was worth 4 of my dollars to at least make a halfhearted attempt to do the reading and i wasn't disappointed. the book clearly explained concepts in cardiovascular (patho)physiology and the chapters weren't overly long. the pharmacology chapters (i.e. treatment of HF) were kind of excruciating but other than that i'll probably return to this book again when i begin studying for the boards.
