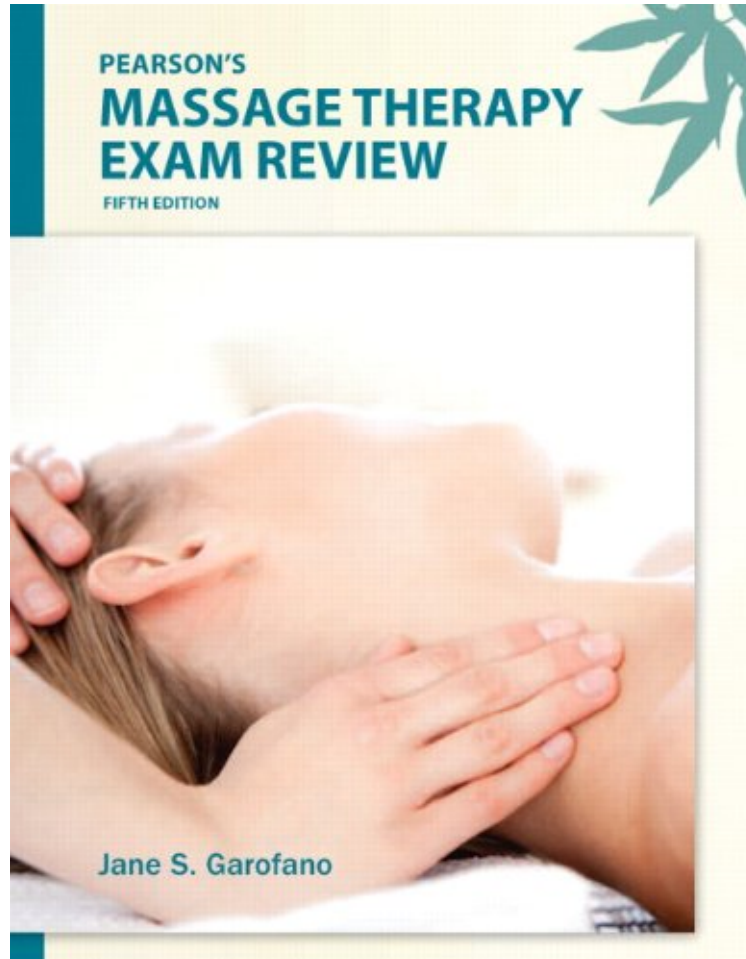

This book has a lot of information that is not on the test, and you can spend many hours studying and wasting your time. So if you are buying this book to prepare you for the exam, I don't recommend it. If you are buying this book to learn more about the field, that's another matter. different answers in the book test versus the online test. I bought this book to help me study the right answers for the MBLEx and I've spent a lot of time investigating which answer is correct. I have to wonder how many more questions have conflicting answers and how many questions just have the wrong answer altogether. I have only gotten thru the first 300 questions so there are many more errors to be found, I'm sure. I don't really feel confident relying on this book. One question that has conflicting answers is "Muscle Energy Technique (MET) can be used to stretch the piriformis muscle in the supine position by?" and the other is: "Immunity acquired as the result of a vaccine is called?" I still have 3 more months before I take the test so I still have time to find alternate study material. Be careful and make sure you investigate all the answers.
