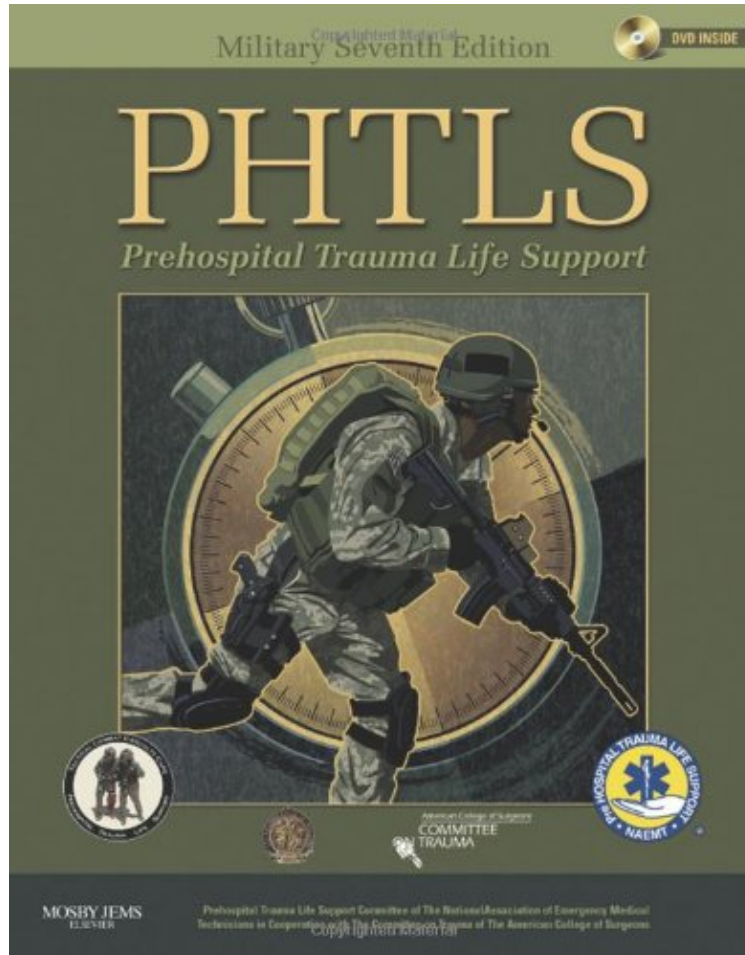

While the NAEMT Contributors did their customary thorough work putting together the 7th Ed...there have already been many significant additions and changes to TCCC that are not discussed in this edition...which is why I recommend waiting for the next issue which should be shortly. I also think it makes a lot

more sense, if NAEMT is going to offer separate courses and course manuals for civilian vs "military" PHTLS, rather than repeating the majority of material in both the civilian and military courses and course books (i.e. the first 20 chapters), they should convert "military" PHTLS into a "Tactical" PHTLS course/course book and design it primarily for use by both the military and federal, state and local law enforcement--along the lines of Tactical Medicine Essentials. If they do that, they could also shorten Tactical PHTLS considerably by deleting the AP from the military-tactical course and keeping that subject matter in the civilian PHTLS course/course book. 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful.
