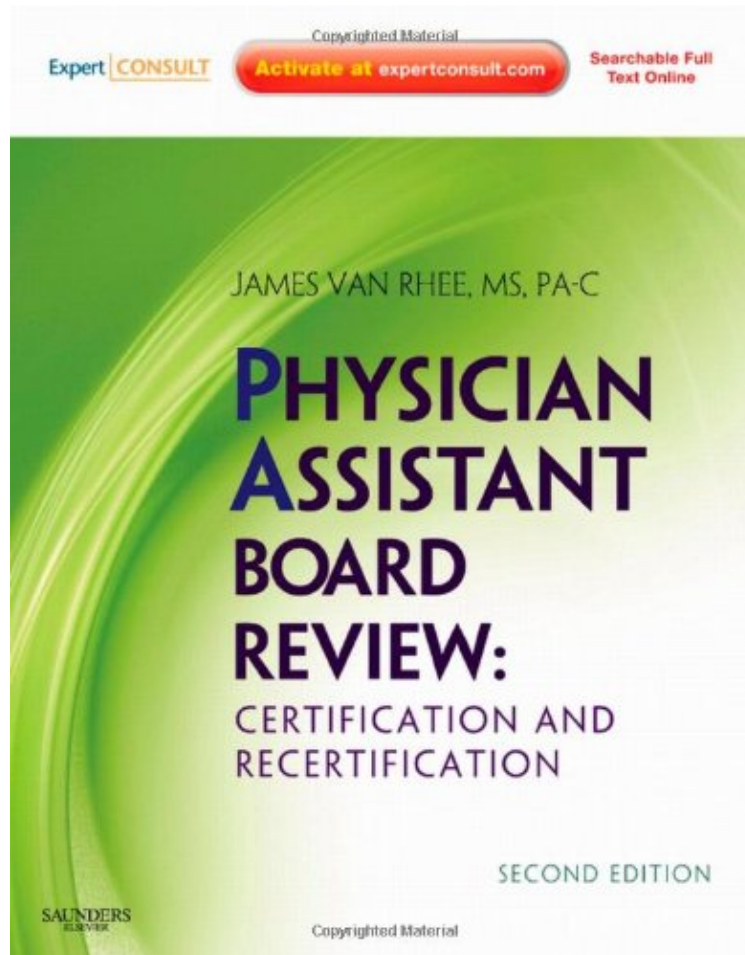

This book was NOT helpful.By HerdG07I'm a clinical year PA student studying for my boards and got this book as another resource to add to my armamentarium. To be brief, I have read several chapters of this book today and cannot believe the amount of misinformation and spelling errors. Basic concepts such as sensitivity and specificity (Ch. 15) are backwards in the text (and correct in the

assessment questions), the text is full of antiquated treatment regimens and there is a vast amount of critical information missing from the chapters. I think this text is a great concept, but how can you market this book to people who will be practicing medicine when the information within clearly has not been proofread or fact checked. I would suggest getting both A Comprehensive Review for the Certification and Recertification Examinations for Physician Assistants, 4th edition and Lange QA Physician Assistant Examination for the PANCE/PANRE and I also believe Step-Up To Medicine, 3rd edition is a great resource for clinical year PA students wishing to learn the most they can on rotations (even though it is a med student book and by no means encompasses all of the PA board topics). By PA2012I have been using "A Comprehensive Review for the Certification and Recertification Examinations for Physician Assistants" by O'Connell and Zarbock 3rd edition to help me with PA school. As I am going to take the PANCE in a few months, I was not sure if I should just get the 4th edition of the same book or get a different one. I decided to go for the second option and I am glad I did. This book has more details than O'Connell including lab medicine and test taking techniques (for example how to set up an schedule for studying prior to take the exam). It also comes with tables in the back with common signs in medicine, dermatomes, cranial nerves, poisoning antidotes, etc...It has about 10 questions at the end of each chapter, so definitely you will need another book with test questions, which I have another 2 or 3. I found it to be the only review book that has questions asked in the top corner of pages while you are reading, to help with improving your memory on what you read. There is also a sentence explaining why the correct answer is correct however does not include explanations as to why the other answer choices are not correct, which I find to be something valuable for truly understanding why an answer is or is not correct.
