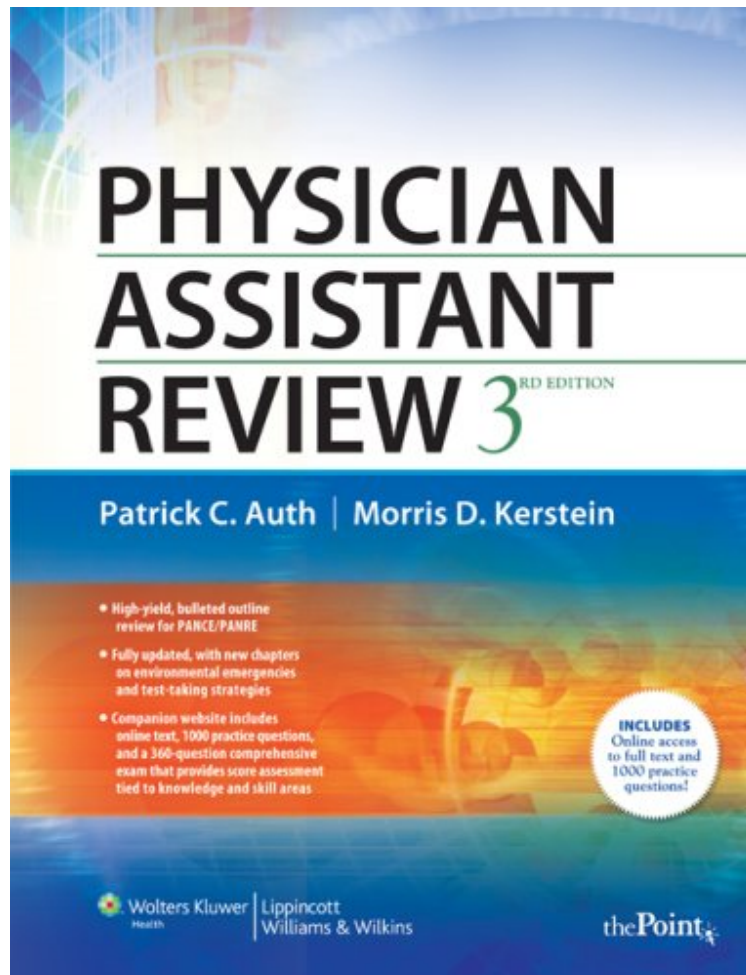

Its in more of an outline format as opposed to huge paragraphs as I've seen in other review books. It does a good job of organizing the material and hitting the important facts. This book would be perfect except one major flaw. It does not follow the NCCPA blueprint. It is lacking some very important disease states which is disappointing. I am having to check off each disease on the blueprint as I go and supplement with another review book which does follow the blueprint (Comprehensive Review for the Certification and Recert Examinatoins for PAs) but isn't nearly as accurate/informative as PA Review 3rd Edition.
