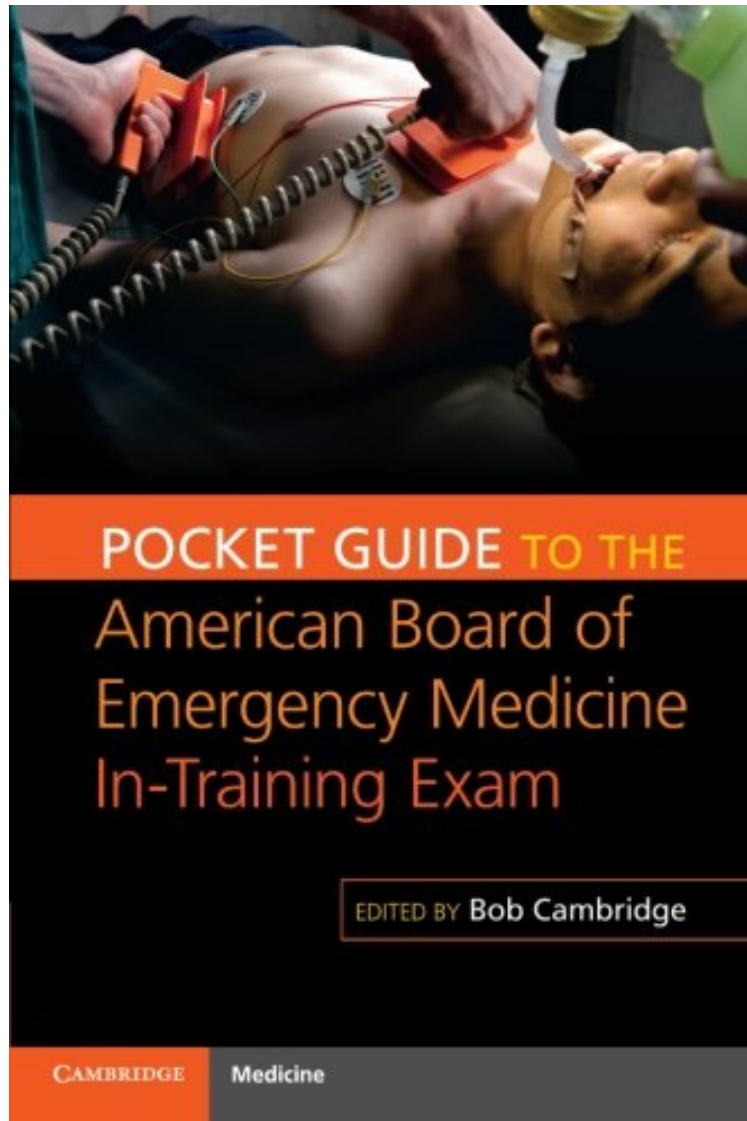

From the 3 sections I've covered, this book is too general and lacking to serve as a strong review. I realize its a review book and not a textbook but only the most basic concepts are covered and they are not covered well. I've looked at several other books from EM pocket guide to ERMA top clinical problems and compared sections. Both would provide more info and also more direct patient care info then this book. One might think a book of this size could serve as a pocket guide for reference during patient care, but it absolutely is not set up to provide that information.
