The fourth section presents minor surgical procedures through a "cookbook" approach. Section Five presents a large amount of material concerning orthotics, pads, straps, appliances, foot care considerations in systemic disease, shoes, physical therapy, over-the-counter products, and local anesthetic and steroid drugs. The final section deals with important aspects of practice economics. Throughout the six sections, the author includes practice tips and clinical management notes which render helpful advice in providing effective care and in avoiding the pitfalls of foot care practice. The text also includes treatment protocols, procedure reports, patient education information, and other information useful in clinical documentation.
