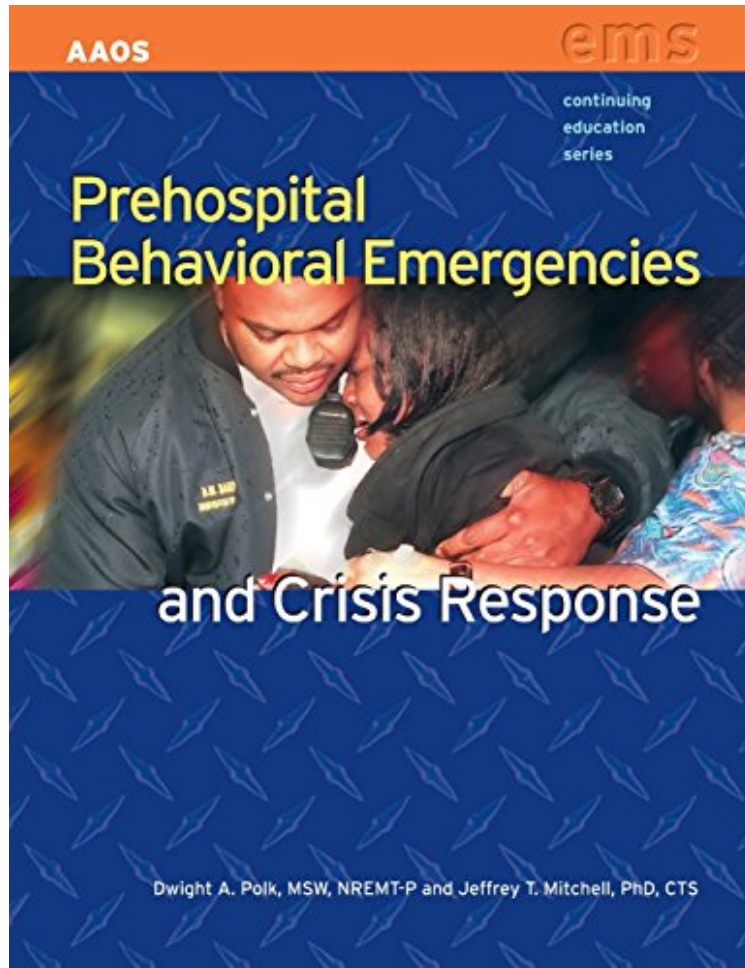

It contained a lot of helpful information, although for certain conditions (like PTSD) it contained little useful information. The book puts in a lot of lengthy, boring sentences that serve as transitions between the sentences with the actual information (sometimes more than one!), which makes the book hard to follow, as it is difficult to pay attention to the authors' obvious attempt to keep you from interestedly reading the book. Aside from this, each chapter

has a glossary and references that aid in the understanding of the chapter, as well as plenty of helpful information (but only if you get past the boring, paragraph-long transition sentences).
