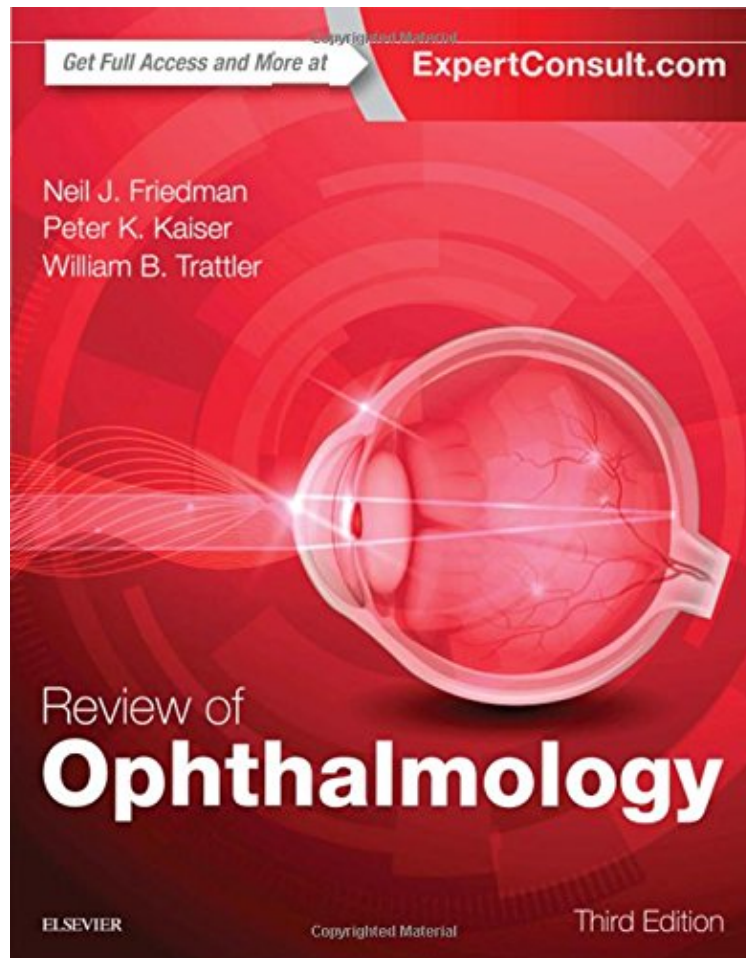

A big improvement to this book would be to add in memory tools/mnemonics similar to the First Aid series.
