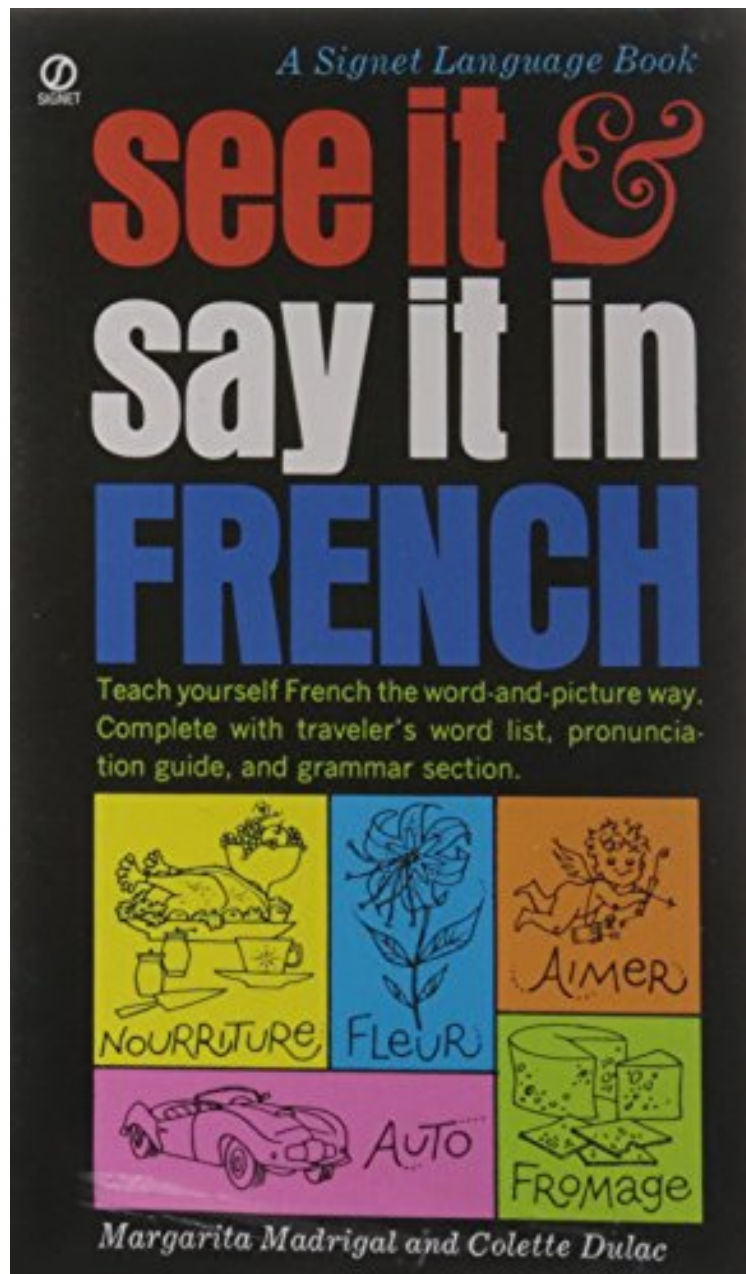

This little book has several main virtues that work together to enable learning French quickly and naturally. First of all, the explanations, starting with pronunciation, are very clear. Next, the learning really is progressive -- starting with very basic French AND using English parallels as much as possible. The phrases are learned via clusters of nearly repeated models via simple substitution -- AND many of those phrases are matched precisely to model pictures. These are grouped by topic in modules and by their topic phrase exercises on facing pages -- for easiest reviewing. Because of the easy progression by topic in such natural modules -- it is also fairly easy to jump around from topic to topic -- to eventually review freely as needed or wanted. This whole pattern is very natural -- closely parallel to natural personal language learning.
