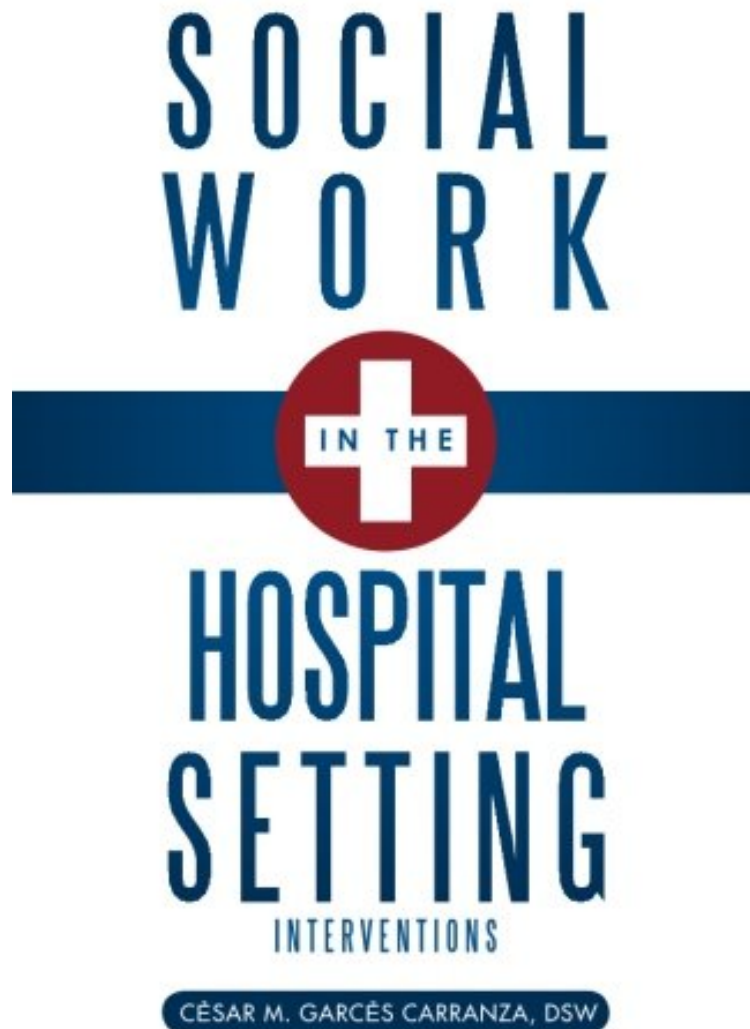

WeinsteinThis book reads like the unedited master's thesis of a social work student for whom English is not the native language. As an ESL teacher myself, I have no bias against English-language learners, but I do wish that this author could have had his work edited by someone who knows English grammar. The book is full of typos and grammatical

errors (including sentence fragments and the use of non-words, e.g. "advices"). More importantly, the book is low on actual content. Several sentences and citations are repeated verbatim throughout the book. The author harps on and on about how underappreciated medical social workers are, without providing a substantive analysis of \*how\* they do what they do. I am a current social work student trying to choose a specialization, and I was discouraged at the prospects of medical social work as a result of reading this book. This book excited me at first, because I'm going into the field of hospital social work and I wanted to learn more about it. I was so excited to see a book made for exactly this subject. However, upon reading, I'm very disappointed. The book has so many grammatical errors and spelling mistakes that it seems no one even bothered to edit it before publishing. There are extra letters on words, spaces where there shouldn't be, misspellings, etc. On page 45 alone I caught FOUR different errors. The language in general is poor, and seems as if it were written by a college freshman. It makes it very hard to be taken seriously when there are sentences like, "They fear mostly that the patient will die soon". The book is also made to seem as if it is intervention based, but it lacks any intervention specifics at all. I have a hard time believing this is a reputable source at all because there are so many red flags. Only one author, poor editing, lack of content, etc. are all huge issues for me. I will be returning.
