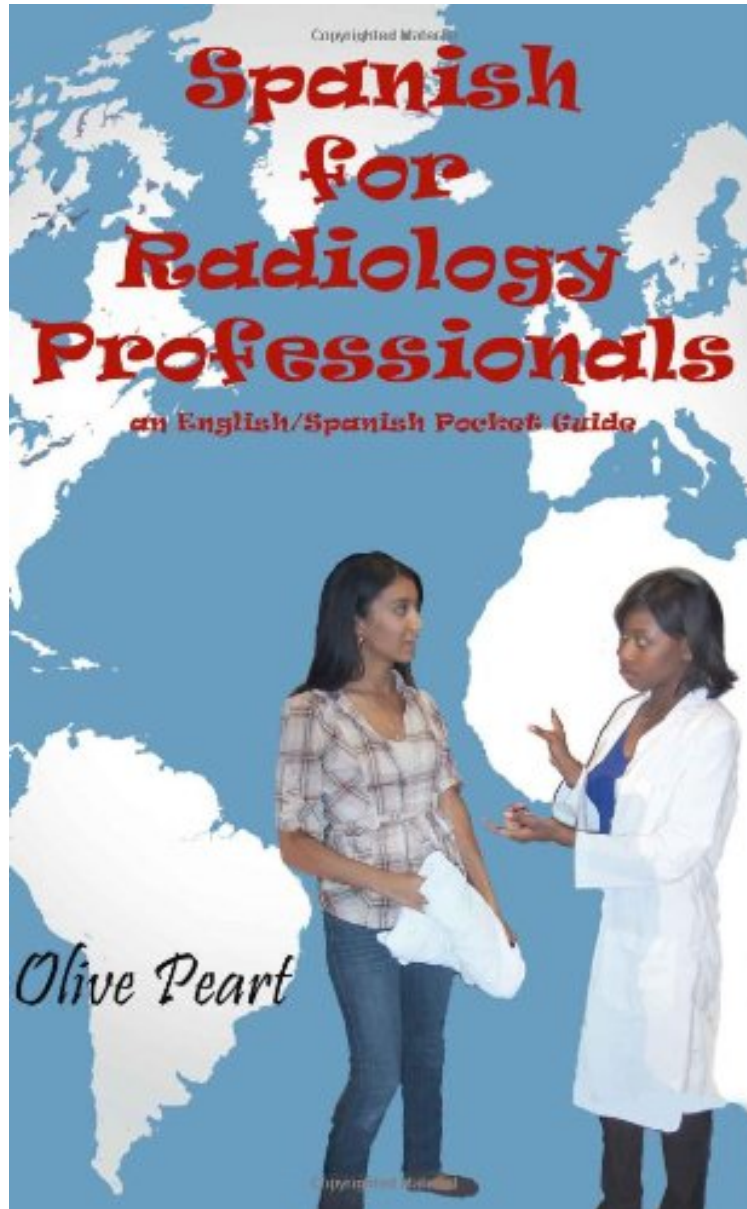

I am thankful that it exists but it has a few flaws. There are a few typos. The use of register--formal vs. informal-- is not completely uniform. While these are not

major issues my biggest concern is that the text does not take into consideration the variations of word means in different parts of the Spanish-speaking world. I believe that "best practices" call for using the "neutral" vocabulary of "Standard Latin American Spanish". The book does not do this. For example: The verb "coger" is used repeatedly.
