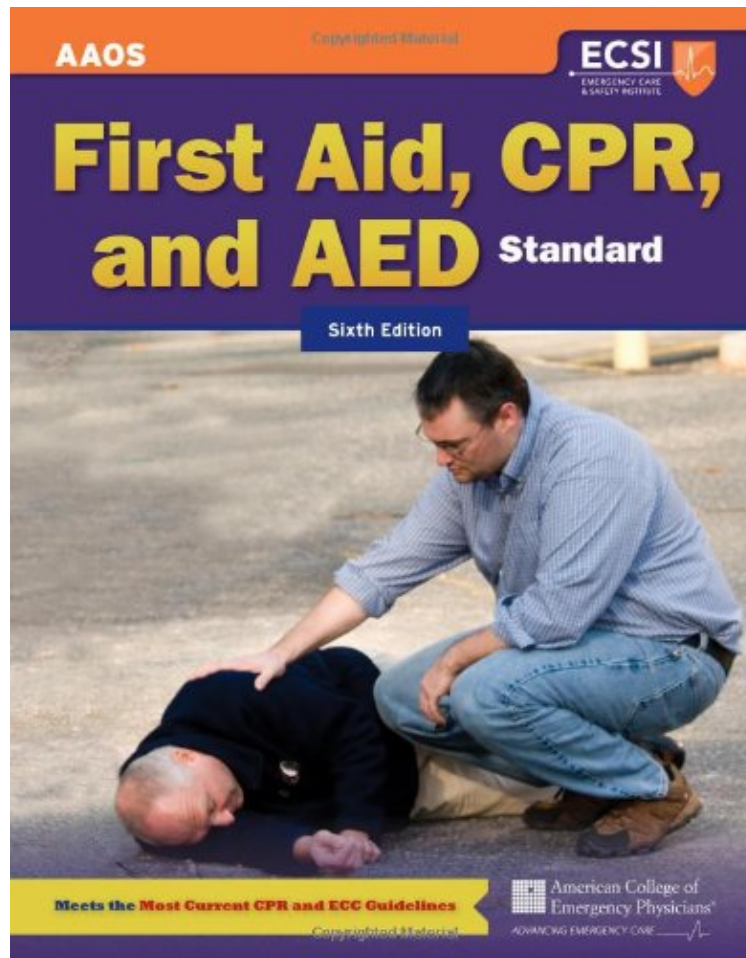

This one is the super skinny book that has hardly any content in it at all. It was certainly not the book required for my class.
