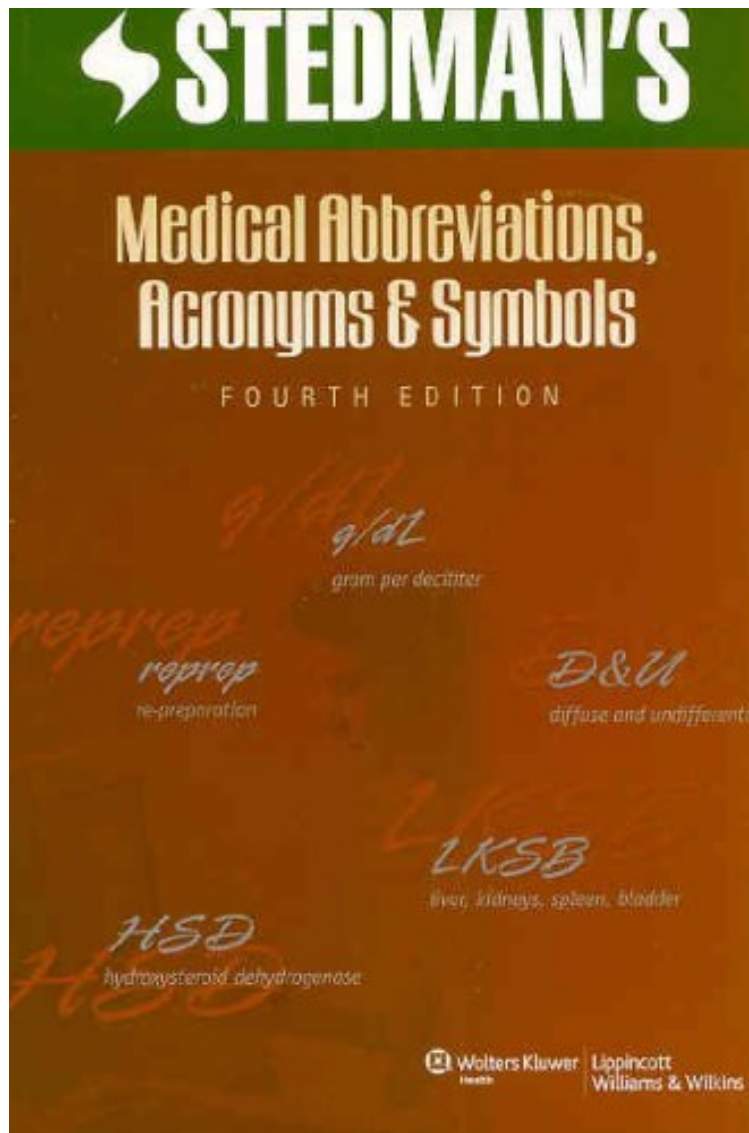

The most used meanings for many abbreviations are highlighted in red ink. The book is surprisingly heavy, but this allows it to lay flat when open. There are several helpful appendices: Symbols; Greek Alphabet; Elements and Their Symbols; ISMP's List of Error-Prone Abbreviations, Symbols, and Dose Designations; Weights and Measures; Professional Titles and Degrees; Professional Associations and Organizations including Government and Regulatory Agencies; Chemotherapy and Other Drug Regimens; and, finally, Clinical Trials.
